**INTRODUCTION**

On or about 10/2/17 at 8:50 PM a serious accident occurred at JSL Foods, Inc. where this employer, Priority Workforce, Inc. (PWF), provides labor. The incident occurred when the employee was cleaning in-running rollers with a rag and spray bottle on a dough brake which is part of Noodle Line #3 in Room P-1. His left hand was partially pulled into the in-running rollers and he lost two of his fingers.

The victim was taken to LAC/USC Medical Center.

**REPORTING REQUIREMENTS:**

The employer, PWF, reported the accident on the same day at 9:53 PM, about an hour after the accident.

DOSH arrived at the scene on 10/8/18 at 1:15 PM and proceeded to inspect, interview and obtain pertinent documents from both PWF and JSL Foods, Inc.

#### CONDITIONS AND FACTORS LEADING TO ACCIDENT:




The employee was injured when they were directed to perform a task that requires LO/TO without being directed to perform LO/TO and without being trained to perform LO/TO. Cleaning a dough brake falls under the activities requiring LO/TO. It was not the policy of JSL Foods, Inc. to have the employees perform LO/TO before cleaning dough brakes. Also, the dough brake was not adequately guarded. Three of the five pairs of in-running rollers had guards that did not prevent fingers from entering the pinch points.

#### CAUSES AND CONCLUSIONS:

Failing to train all authorized employees to perform LO/TO before cleaning the dough brake was one cause of the accident. The supervisor who assigned the employee to clean this dough brake did not direct him to perform LO/TO. This was another cause of the accident.
